

## Environmental Policy

Komatsu Awazu Plant's mission is to further improve the technologies cultivated through the development and production of our products, to promote environmental management activities while actively pursuing business activities that take into consideration the protection of plant site land as well as the surrounding community and the global environment, and to contribute to building a society where sustainable development is possible.

- (1) We will comply with laws and regulations relating to the environment, follow the Komatsu Earth Environment Charter, and work on environmental conservation and preventing environmental pollution.
- (2) Through our regular operations, we will consider the effect our business activities may have on the environment, and to avoid environmental risks, we will set goals to reduce the environmental burden and continually work on improvement activities.
- (3) Taking the global environment into consideration, we will work towards CO<sub>2</sub> reduction in our development and production activities.
- (4) By engaging in resource-saving activities that take the global environment into consideration, we will work to use resources (materials, water, etc.) effectively and reduce the amount of industrial waste produced.
- (5) We will actively make environmental protection efforts (biodiversity) in the former site of Yusenji Copper Mine, the original home to Komatsu, and promote environmental communication.
- (6) These policies will be made known to all employees who work at the Awazu Plant through education and awareness building activities.
