## Oyama Area Environmental Policy

### 1. Basic Philosophy

The basic philosophy of the Oyama Plant and the Tochigi Plant is to further improve the technology cultivated thus far and promote environmental management activities through the development and production of products. At the same time, in addition to complying with the laws of the region in which our plants are located, we will engage in our business activities in such a way that the next generation can inherit the global environment in a healthy state. We will also work to contribute to sustainable development as we continue to fulfill our corporate social responsibilities.

### 2. Environmental Policy

- 1) We will engage in business activities in such a way that is in harmony and cooperation with the local residents.
- 2) We will comply with the laws and regulations concerning the environment, and follow the Komatsu Earth Environment Charter to make efforts to prevent pollution and improve the environment.
- 3) In our regular operations, we will take into consideration the environmental impact and set goals and targets to continually engage in improvement activities.
- 4) We will promote energy-and-resource-saving activities by developing and manufacturing products which take the global environment into consideration.
- 5) We will continually maintain Zero Emissions activities as an effort to build a recycling-oriented society.
- 6) Everyone who works in the Oyama area will become aware of the environmental impact of our business activities, and will conduct education-and -awareness-building activities regarding environmental conservation.
- 7) We will engage in priority environmental management, as we are fully aware of the fact that our usage of oils is the largest amount in the area. We will also promote stringent control of chemical substances.
- 8) We will recognize biodiversity as one of the key issues of the global environment, and make conservation efforts for the global environment.
- 9) Focusing on the Komatsu Mid-term Plan, we are advancing efforts relating to climate change, carbon neutrality, ESG issues and the SDGs as efforts to address these issues have accelerated worldwide.
